

Minutes of the District Development Board Meeting Bandipore 2017-18, held on 20TH of April 2017 at 11:00 a.m. under the Chairmanship Hon'ble Minister for Youth Services & Sports, Information Technology and Technical Education Jammu & Kashmir State Chairman DDBM Bandipora at Banquet Hall Srinagar.

At the outset, the District Development Commissioner Bandipore threw light on Physical and Financial achievements of the District for the last financial year, 2016-17. While highlighting the performance for the year 2016-17, it was intimated that an amount of Rs. 5042.90 lac was actually made available under District Capex Budget 2016-17, out of which the expenditure incurred was to the tune of Rs. 4648.22 lac up to ending March, 2017 with component-wise break up as under:-

The District Development Commissioner Bandipore highlighted that Schemes/ Projects/Works costing Rs. 136.00 crore have been completed in the District under District Sector/ State Sector/ Flagship Programmes and Centrally Sponsored Schemes during the financial year 2016-17, which include 11 Road Projects, 02 Projects under District Infrastructure, 03 WSS schemes, 02 irrigation Schemes, 27 School Buildings, 07 Health Institutions and 1699 MGNREGA Works, 1511 works under 14th FC. Besides, 40,770 beneficiaries were covered under various Social Welfare Schemes.

The District CAPEX Budget 2017-18 was approved by the District Dev. Board to the tune of Rs. 10553.60 lac, with component wise breakup as under:-

He informed that Chief Engineer R&B has submitted the DPR of 13 road projects to the Adm. Deptt. of R&B Deptt. for approval which is awaited till date.
